Fees include a \$200 Administrative Fee, a \$150 Academic Success Fee, and a \$200 Technology Fee for each and every 10-week term, and a \$150 Graduation Fee. A one-time \$225 Fee is applied to programs with an externship or clinical component. All programs require a \$25 non-refundable application fee, effective 6/27/2024.

Course repeat fee: \$400 per failing course.

Reentry fee: \$150

Students are billed each quarter based on the number of credit hours in which they are enrolled for the quarter and the cost per credit hour for their program. Full time students must take a minimum of twelve (12) quarter credit hours or

a maximum of nineteen (19) quarter credit hours per term. Although Stautzenberger College encourages all students to attend full time occasionally students may attend part-time. If a student is attending part-time, financial aid will be adjusted based on actual hours attended.

Ohio War Orphans Scholarship

The Ohio War Orphans Scholarship Program awards tuition assistance to the children of deceased or severely disabled Ohio veterans who served in the armed forces during a period of declared war or conflict.
